

The Woodlands Inn is a welcome alternative to traditional, and often clinical, care centers. Designed with details that resemble a charming New England inn, each of our four state-of-the-art, specialized homes accommodates just ten resident members, creating an intimate, family-style atmosphere and opportunities for personal connection.

Daily life centers around a central hearth area where members can gather to engage in conversation, watch a movie, participate in a variety of engaging programs, or simply enjoy the warmth of the fire on a chilly day. Large windows bathe the space in natural light and provide views of each home's gardens and the surrounding woodlands.

The open kitchen and dining area is also a center of activity. At The Woodlands Inn, our chef oversees menu selection and meal preparation for each home, incorporating Edgewood's farm-to-table philosophy and the freshest locally sourced ingredients available. Meals are prepared in each home's open kitchen and members are welcome to observe or join in the preparation before dining together.

For privacy and comfort, each member also enjoys his or her own master suite and master bathroom. These private living quarters are arranged around the central hearth area to foster a sense of community within the home and provide easy access to amenities.

Consistent, highly trained teams of Innkeepers are a central feature of the small-home model at The Woodlands Inn. As a steady and reliable presence in members' lives, Innkeepers serve a variety of roles within the home. They're friends who get to know each resident member, learning about their histories and families, as well as their routines and preferences. They're the helping hands who provide personal care and assistance. They're leaders who are empowered to serve members' needs in the best way possible. They're organizers who plan routines, social events and recreational opportunities to match members' interests and build a sense of family within the home. And they're encouragers who empower members to embrace their highest potential for independence.

Consistent Staffing: Resident members and their families can rest easy knowing that their consistent team of Innkeepers and support staff are taking care of the home 24 hours a day, seven days a week. In addition, a licensed nurse provides oversight and assistance eight hours a day.


- Skilled Nursing Care (short-term rehab or long-term care)
